

3rd Party Financing - Creating POs

This document is a quick reference guide for users who will be creating orders using 3rd Party Financing in the Arizona Procurement Portal (APP). A complete order utilizing 3rd Party Financing requires 2 POs - One for the commodity being purchased (not encumbered) and one for the supplier providing the financing for the purchase [to make payments on the financing (encumbered)]. In order to create or view a 3rd Party Financing purchase order (not encumbered), a Requester must have the 'Requester-3rd Party Financing' role assigned to their APP profile. Before assigning the Requester-3rd Party Financing role at least one approval rule must be created for that document type.

Creating the Commodity PO (Not Encumbered) - PO #1

- 1. Log into APP
- 2. Create on-contract requisition.
- 3. In the Requisition Type dropdown, select 3rd Party Financing.

- 4. Click Save.
- 5. Complete all requisition required fields, line items details and budget information.



- 6. Once you are complete adding all your requisition details, click **Submit for Approval**.
- 7. On the final approval the requisition will flip to a PO but will not create an encumbrance. A PO notification will be sent to the supplier as normal.
- 8. You will be able to create receipts for this PO and then close it. **DO NOT CREATE INVOICES FOR THIS PO**. All invoices will fail on the integration to AFIS step as no encumbrance has been created.



Creating the Financing PO (Encumbered) - PO #2

- 1. Once equipment has been received and the financing package has been approved, create the on-contract PO for the amount of financing to be paid in the current fiscal year.
- 2. Process the requisition following standard purchasing procedure the resulting PO will create an encumbrance in AFIS.
 - a. **Highly recommended:** Add documentation in the Comments section on the requisition tying the financing PO to the commodity purchase.
- 3. Create receipts and invoices against this PO as normal.
