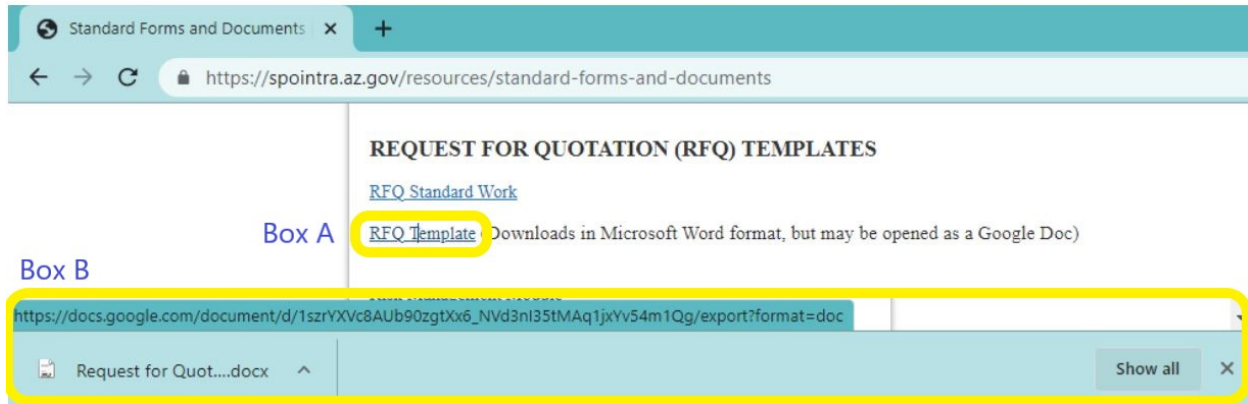


Accessing Files via the SPO Intranet

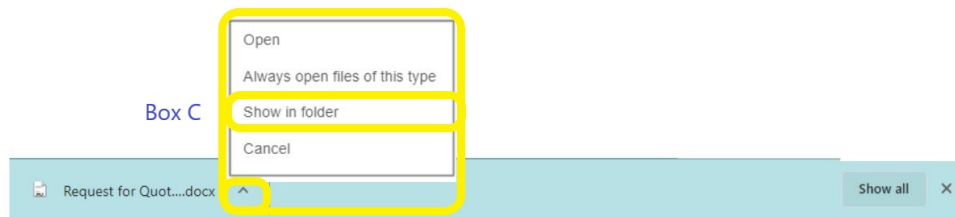
Purpose: This is a guideline showing an example of accessing a Microsoft Word template that may also be opened as a Google Doc format.

1. Once a link is double clicked (Box A), the downloaded file (Box B) should appear on the bottom; clicking on it will open the file.

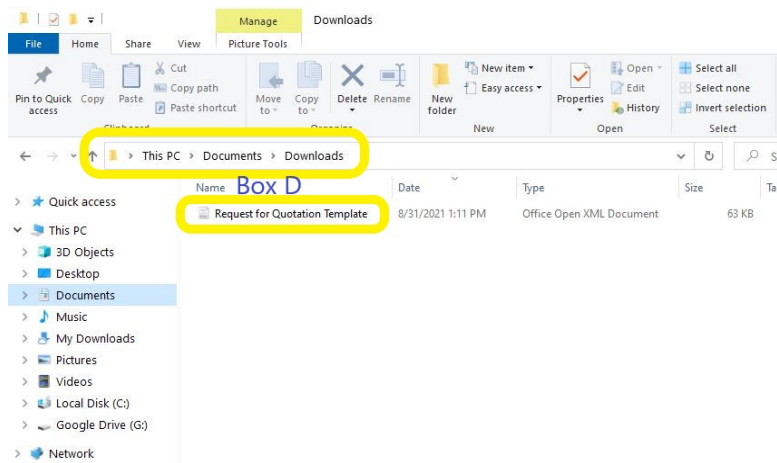


2. Another way to open the downloaded file shown in Box B above is to show the folder location or path of the file as shown in the following:

- a. Click on the "Λ" icon and choose "Show in folder" (Box C).



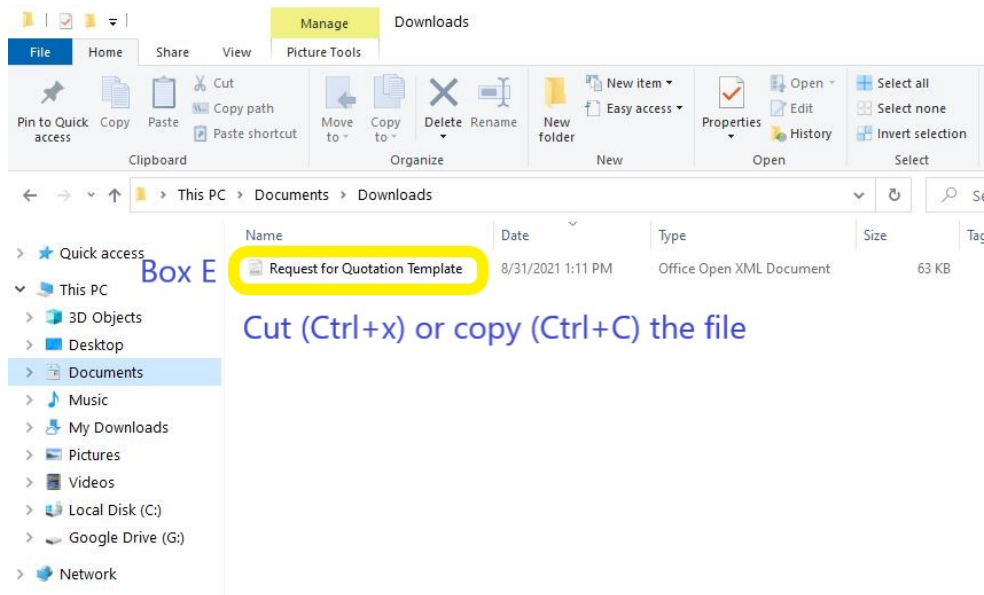
- b. The File Explorer window will appear (Box D) and once the file is clicked, it will open as a Microsoft Word format. *Note: Usually, the file will be downloaded to the default folder, which is file path "This PC > Documents > Downloads" (Box D); if not, you may have customized the location.*



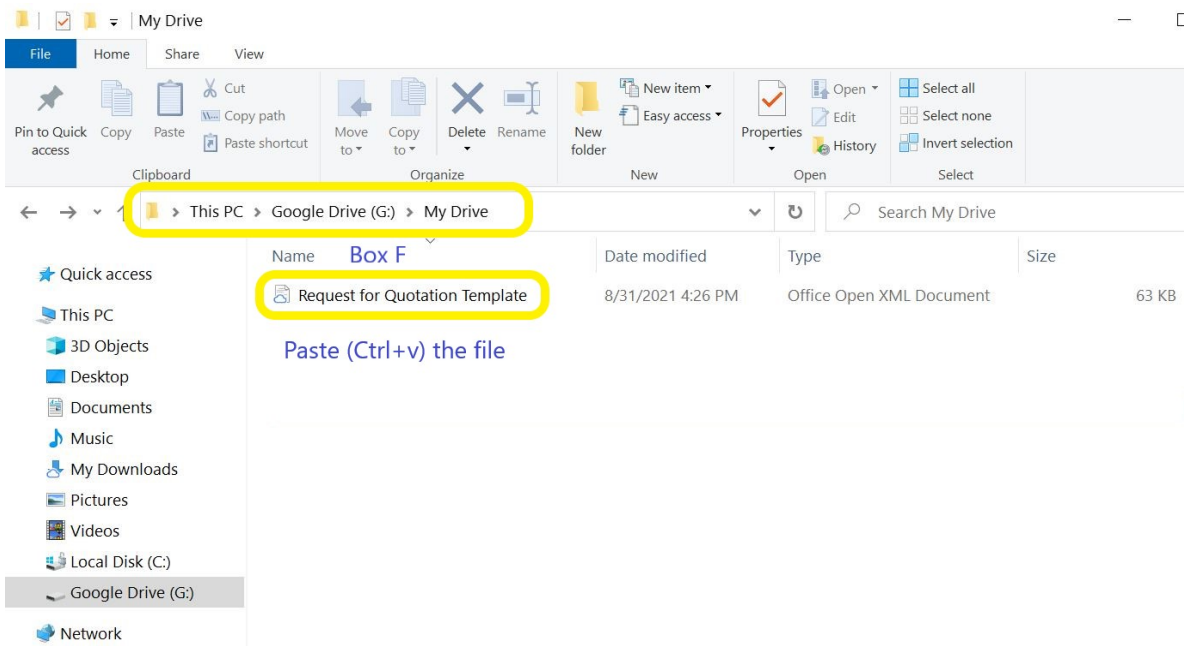

Purpose: This is a guideline showing an example of accessing a Microsoft Word template that may also be opened as a Google Doc format.

3. If the same downloaded file is preferred to be opened as a Google Doc format, do the following:
 - a. Right click on the file (Box E) and cut or copy it by pressing “Ctrl+x” or “Ctrl+c” on the keyboard. *Note: Another way to do these is by right clicking on the file and choosing either “cut” or “copy” from the list of options (not shown).*



- b. Go to the “Google Drive (G:)” via file path “This PC > Google Drive (G:) > My Drive” (Box F) and paste the file by pressing “Ctrl+v” on the keyboard. *Note: Another way to do this is by right clicking on the file and choosing “paste” from the list of options (not shown).*

- c. Go to your “Google My Drive” via “<https://drive.google.com/drive/my-drive>”. Right click on the file, go to “Open with”, and choose “Google Docs” (Box G).
